Expectations and Understanding for Students Who Receive Early Release/Late Arrival

The Early Release and Late Arrival are privileges in which the school maintains the discretion to revoke at any time for failure to comply with any of the following expectations. Students must:

- 1. Comply with all school rules.
- 2. Understand that schedule changes will not be considered to accommodate Early Release/ Late Arrival.
- 3. Provide their own transportation to/ from school.
- 4. Students who are failing courses and/or are in jeopardy of not graduating, will have their early releases and/or late arrivals removed by administration.
- 5. For Early Release:
 - a. Leave campus at the approved time and return no earlier than 2:20 pm for after-school activities. Students cannot remain in the building.

- b. Report to school each day early enough to check-in and arrive to their first scheduled class *on time*. Failure to do this will result in having this privilege revoked.

Procedure for Requesting Early Release/Late Arrival

Early Release/Late Arrival Preference (Please Check One)

- 1. Complete this form (including parent signature) and return it to the Guidance office.
- 2. Requests for Early Release or Late Arrival will be handled in the following manner:
 - a.) Early Requests (by May 1st): If your request is received by May 1st, your schedule for the following year will be generated over the summer and then reviewed to determine whether or not Early Release / Late Arrival will fit into it. You will not know until the first day of school if you have an Early Release / Late Arrival. Your form must be signed by a parent / guardian and returned to the Guidance office by May 1st to be considered for this option.
 - b.) <u>During School Year</u>: Once you receive a schedule you can request an Early Release/ Late Arrival <u>only</u> if you have Study Hall(s) scheduled in the beginning or the end of your day. You must meet the academic and attendance criteria listed above and complete this form and return it to the Guidance office. The Early Release/ Late Arrival will not go into effect until you receive the changes on your schedule.
