#### **Academic Guidance**

Academic advice and guidance on summer school courses must be sought and obtained before beginning the summer school program, as the program does not staff school counselors.

#### **Transportation**

There is **no** transportation provided for students attending the summer school program. Transportation to and from the summer school program is the responsibility of parents and students.

#### **Summer Health**

**Attendance at ALL 12 scheduled classes in the session is required to receive credit.**

#### **Program Attendance**

**\*\*Student attendance at all classes for all assigned courses to recover credit is MANDATORY. Students will be dismissed from the program after their third (3rd) absence.**

Due to strict NYS specified minimum hours of attendance requirements, no special dispensation may be given for summer program absence(s). Any suspension from the summer program will be considered an absence.

Parent/guardians will be informed after each class absence and at the point in which their child is at-risk of being dropped from the program.

#### **Student Behavior**

The District Code of Conduct is in effect during the summer school program. Students are expected to abide by the dress code and behavioral expectations.

#### **Academic Performance**

Students and parents are encouraged to monitor academic progress using the infinite campus portal. Parents are also encouraged to communicate directly with summer school teachers to monitor student progress in summer classes.
