

“Greetings,

As part of our school district's initiative to provide 1:1 computing, your child will receive a Chromebook on Wednesday November 6. This Chromebook will be used in class and at home. The Chromebook will be contained in protective case with a charging cable.

- Students are responsible for having a charged Chromebook and keeping it locked in their locker when it is not in their possession (ie...lunch, after school activities such as sports, etc)
- Before a student can be issued a Chromebook on November 6, we ask that all students and parents review the Chromebook Handbook by clicking [\[Chromebook Handbook\]](#) and then sign the Chromebook Use Pledge which can be downloaded by clicking [\[Chromebook Use Pledge\]](#).
- The pledge form must be returned to their Mod 1 teacher on November 6.
- Parents are responsible for the repair cost if the Chromebook is damaged or broken.
- We encourage all parents to read and complete the insurance policy form. Checks for this insurance can be sent to the middle school main office.
