Family and Consumer Sciences- Not your Grandma's Home Economics!

A few months ago at a coffee clutch gathering, I was asked what has changed about Home Economics. The first answer I thought of was “Well boys are allowed in the classes now too!” This got some chuckles from the crowd, but Home Economics really has changed a lot over time. Back in 1994, Home Economics officially changed its name to Family and Consumer Sciences (FCS). What used to be thought of as wife and homemaker education has transformed into a scientific, evidence based discipline that teaches the life skills needed to take care of the physical and social needs of yourself, your family, and those around you. Students learn things like how to execute a quick meal, how to sew a button back onto their shirt, how to relieve stress, and how to excel at a job in Early Childhood Education. FCS classes also provide a great opportunity for students to see the knowledge gained from core classes in real life- from dividing a recipe in half or measuring a perfect square of fabric, to understanding the science of a baby's brain and how childcare practices have changed throughout history.

Auburndale's Family and Consumer Sciences courses include: 7th/8th Grade Exploratory FCS, Culinary 1, Culinary 2, Healthy Choices, Infant and Toddler Development, Elements of Design 1, and Elements of Design 2. We are very fortunate to be in a district that supports these courses and understands that students need these people-centered skills to be successful after high school graduation no matter where life takes them.

The Auburndale seventh grade girls' basketball team participated in the Wisconsin State Invitational Championship Tournament (WSICT) April 9-10. The tournament, organized by The Great Northwest Basketball League, brought together over 50 of the top seventh grade girls basketball teams across Wisconsin to play over the weekend. Schools were split based on enrollment into Division 1, Division 2, Division 3, or Division 4/5.

The Auburndale seventh graders went undefeated in their tournament, bringing home the State Championship. Auburndale defeated Laconia 46-24 and Bangor 34-23 in pool play. In a round of 16, Auburndale overpowered Poynette 40-23.

Quarterfinal action pinned Auburndale against La Crosse Aquinas, Auburndale coming out on top 43-21. Continuing in the semi-final game, Auburndale defeated Mineral Point 33-14. The State Championship game was a repeat of Auburndale and Laconia, who competed in game one of pool play. While a much closer game than their first match up, Auburndale persevered and won 45-38.
