## To: ALL PRINCIPALS

The laws of Mississippi and our national and community safety require that monthly fire drills be conducted in all schools. You are there fore directed to set-up and conduct a minimum of one drill each month of the ensuing school year.

As evidence of our full compliance with the law and as a matter of public record each principal is to conduct two fire drills during the first two weeks of school and a total of 10 fire drills for the school year. Immediately after each fire drill, the principal will complete the following information and send to the Director of Support Services.
