

422 - ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS OTHER THAN OPEN ENROLLMENT STUDENTS

Tuition for attendance in District may be charged for any non-district student who is not a part of the Wisconsin Open Enrollment Program. Tuition charges shall be based on the actual additional costs of instruction as determined by the District. Tuition may be paid by the parent(s), a guardian, the county, or another school district.

Parent(s)/Guardian(s)

- All tuition contracts between the parent(s)/guardian(s) and the Board shall be in writing and signed by both parties
- A student will not be permitted to enter school until the signed agreement is on file in the District office
- Tuition must be paid in advance by the semester.

County or Other School District

- Tuition for students referred by other school districts shall be paid by the county or the school district in which the referring school is located - Tuition charges shall be based upon actual additional costs of instruction to the district or by a mutually agreed upon amount by the resident and non-resident district
- A student will not be permitted to enter school until a signed agreement is on file in the District office
- Under State law, the District is not required to enroll a student during the term of his/her expulsion from any other school district

Exception: The Board does waive tuition for 12th grade students to complete their senior year without payment of tuition, if their parents and/or the student become non-residents during the school year. In addition, the Board does waive tuition for foreign exchange students.

All requirements regarding health examinations and immunizations which apply to resident students shall also apply to non-resident students who enroll in the District schools.
