

## **443.4 - USE OR POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, DRUGS, OR PARAPHERNALIA**

Drinking, possession, or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, or paraphernalia by students on school property or at any school function under supervision of school authority, whether it is on or off school campus, is forbidden.

No student who has had an alcoholic beverage to drink, ingested drugs, or has paraphernalia, may come to any function of the school. Evidence of consumption of alcoholic beverages, or under the influence of drugs, is sufficient reason to be denied permission to attend classes or school sponsored events. Students may also be detained pending notification of parents and law enforcement authorities. The consequences for such action starts with a suspension from school, referral to law enforcement, and possible referral to the School Board for expulsion. Subsequent offenses will result in an automatic referral to the School Board for expulsion.

For the purposes of this policy, “drugs” shall mean:

- A. all dangerous controlled substances as so designated by the Wisconsin Statutes;
- B. all derivatives of hemp. This includes Delta-8-THC, Delta-9-THC, Delta-10-THC, Delta-11-THC, THC-0, and all other forms that causes psychosis; in all forms of delivery (i.e., inhalation, ingestion, injection, etc.).
- C. all chemicals which release toxic vapors;
- D. all alcoholic beverages;
- E. any prescription or patent drug, except those for which permission to use in school has been granted pursuant to Board policy;
- F. “look-alikes” or synthetics;
- G. anabolic steroids;
- H. any other illegal substance so designated and prohibited by law.
