

453.63 – DO NOT RESUSCITATE

In emergency situations, students wearing an official white DNR (Do Not Resuscitate) bracelet recognized by the State of Wisconsin will be treated as required by sections 154.17 through 154.29 of the Wisconsin State Statutes and Chapter HFS 125 of the Wisconsin Administrative Code.

The following steps should be initiated with regard to a DNR event:

1. Evacuate other students and staff from the immediate area
2. Telephone 911
3. Contact the School Nurse/Health Coordinator and/or Building Administrator
4. Contact student's parent(s)/guardian(s)
5. Provide the student with appropriate comfort measures until EMT's arrive
6. Relinquish student to EMT's upon their arrival

Resuscitation "does not" include the Heimlich maneuver or similar procedure used to expel an obstruction from the throat.

Note: The DNR order only applies to a student eighteen years of age or older [State Stat. 154.17 (4)].
