g. Technology Lease Authorization to Bid

Motion: To authorize bidding for a new 3 year Technology Lease with anticipated bid award December 20, 2011.

Note: We have maintained a line item in the general fund budget the last 3 years in the amount of \$63,868, and the balance of \$20,000 has been paid out of the Child Care Profits. The lease will be structured with a half payment this fiscal year, full payments in 2012/13 and 2013/14, and another half payment in 2014/15. The proceeds will be used to fund equipment in the 3 year technology budget, and possibly replacement copiers in the third year if so needed.

h. Approval of Wireless Equipment

Motion: To approve the purchase of wireless equipment from Office Solutions, Inc. (NJ WSCA State Contract # 73981) per their proposal in the amount of \$15,969 to be installed over winter break and funded with escrow funds of the new technology lease.
