RE: Concussion Policy

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Law P.L. 2010, Chapter 94 was passed in 2010. This law mandates measures to be taken to ensure the safety of kindergarten through grade 12 student athletes who participate in Interscholastic Athletics in New Jersey. The legislation (N.J.S.A. 18A:40-41.4) required schools that participate in interscholastic athletics to adopt a policy concerning the prevention and treatment of sports-related concussions and other head injuries among student athletes.

Our school physician, Dr. Ronald Frank and his associate Dr. Sean Cook developed a School Concussion Management Program that directs staff, parent and student education regarding the prevention, recognition, and treatment of concussions and head injuries. As a school physician Dr. Frank recognizes that concussions and head injuries can occur at school during non-sport related activities. To protect all of our students the guidelines in the Concussion Management Program apply to all CPS students at all times.
