NOTICE TO PARENTS

As a parent of a student at a campus receiving Title I funds, federal law allows you to ask for information about the certification, college major, and advanced degrees of your child's teacher(s). You also have the right to request information about the qualifications of a teacher, aide or paraprofessional providing direct services to your child. New procedures for transportation changes Effective immediately

As always, our top priority is the safety and security of our students and staff. With that in mind, we are implementing changes to our front desk communication procedures to ensure that we receive transportation and other changes in a timely manner.

First, changes to transportation should be kept to a minimum, and must be in writing with a signature or a picture of your ID attached.

The note changing transportation can be sent with the student in the morning or faxed to the Adam FAX number 281-517-2089.

If you forget to send a note and do not have access to a FAX machine, you will need to call the front office at 281-897-4485. They will direct you where to send the email to make that change.

DO NOT SEND AN EMAIL WITHOUT MAKING A PHONE CALL TO FRONT DESK. We will no longer have one email dedicated to making changes to transportation.

Changes in transportation must be made prior to 2:30 PM.

These same procedures will apply to students leaving early or letting us know someone else is picking up or having lunch with your child. The latest you can pick up your child from the front office is 3:30 PM.

Dress Code Reminders

- Shorts should be mid-thigh length or longer
- Crop tops or shirts with spaghetti straps are not allowed to be worn to school
- Jeans may not have rips or holes above the mid-thigh area
- Pajamas may only be worn on designated pajama days determined by school staff (principal, homeroom teacher, etc)
- Hats may only be worn on spirit days if your student wears an Adam spirit shirt

If a student is wearing clothing in violation of the Dress Code, they will be asked to change and a change of clothing will have to be provided by the parent/guardian. The nurse is not able to supply clothes to change into.

Lunch Visitors:

- All lunch visitors must have a valid ID to be scanned.
- Lunch visitors must wear their visitor sticker on their shirt where it is visible.
- Parents/Guardians may only eat with their student.
- If someone besides a parent or guardian would like to eat with a student (grandparent, aunt, uncle, etc), the parent/guardian must send a written note giving permission.
- Students will return to their homeroom table when the lights are turned off during the last few minutes to ensure we have a smooth transition to recess or back to the classroom.
- Parents/guardians may leave when the lights are turned off in the cafeteria and the student returns to their table.
