DESCRIPTION:

In CMAS, a music and audio production career pathway, students gain significant, real-world, industry training while refining their own creative process. Students have the opportunity to perform at live events and for the CMAS record label. This pathway encourages music creation while learning the fundamentals of the recording studio industry standard software and standard practices. Students can earn Fine Arts, Career and Technical Education, and even college credit, for their work. This pathway prepares students for the Society of Broadcast Engineers Licensed Radio Operator certification.
