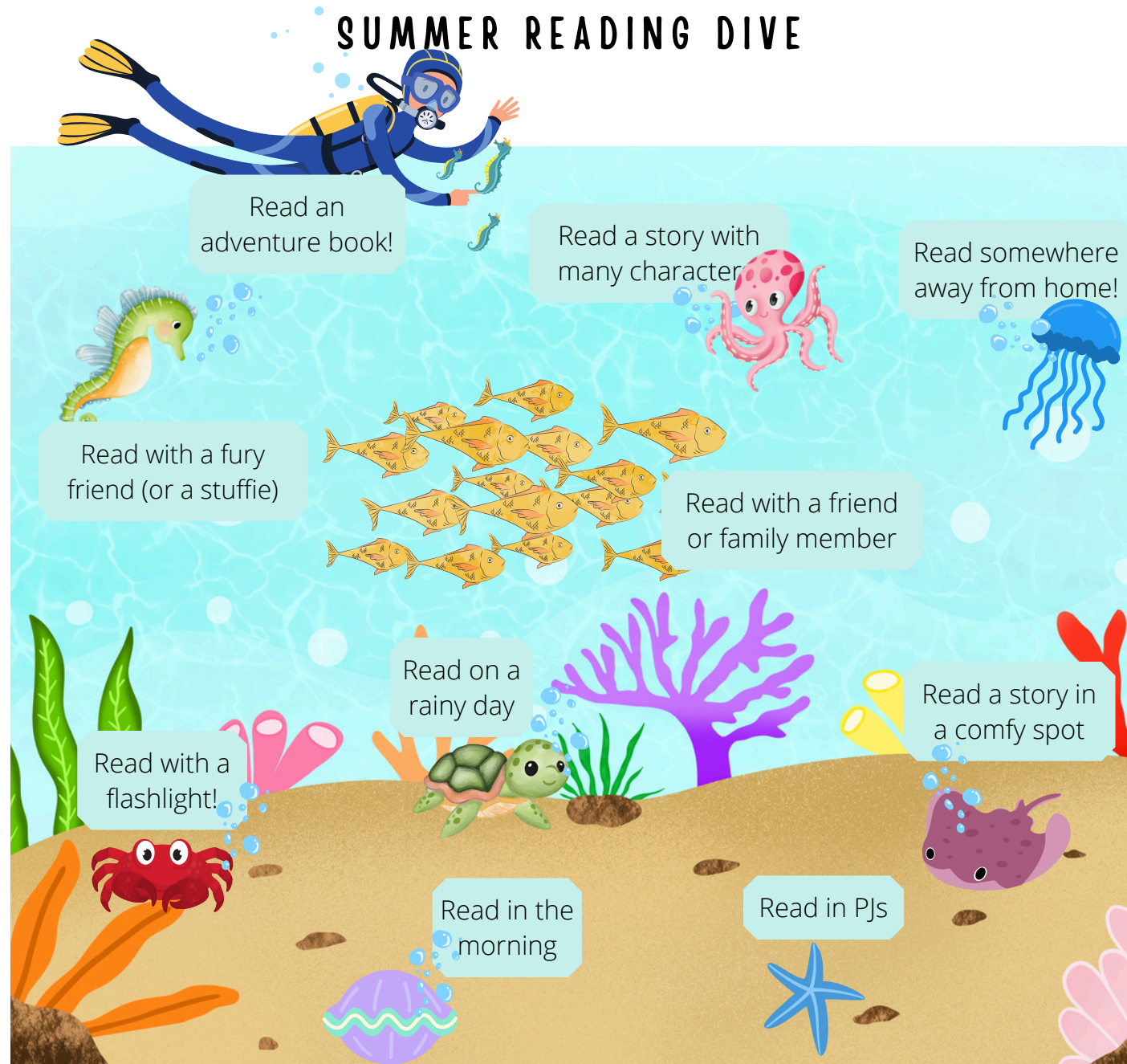
Welcome, Sayre Readers!
