The Therapy Occupations program provides students with an in-depth study of therapeutic careers like physical therapy, occupational therapy, sports injury rehabilitation, etc. It includes information about injury prevention, evaluation, treatment, rehabilitation, emergency injury management and administrative functions. Students in this program participate in internship opportunities and prepare for industry recognized certifications.
