



COVID-19 Protocols for Students

2021-22 School Year

Quarantine Requirements

- Symptomatic
- Positive case in the home
- Tests positive for COVID-19

Quarantine/Exposure Period

- Test positive: quarantine 5 days; may return after 5 days, if no symptoms; must wear mask for the remaining 5 days
- Exposure: Boosted, fully vaccinated within 6 months Moderna/Pfizer (2 months J&J), masks for 10 days. Test on day 5, if no symptoms
- Not boosted, fully vaccinated over 6 months Moderna/Pfizer (over 2 months J&J). Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear mask for 5 days. Test on day 5, if no symptoms

- Signed assurance to return to school



Testing

- District will continue its testing clinic
- Testing must be scheduled by district personnel
- Testing is free

Remote Conferencing

- Students participate in 4 hours of remote time per day
- Time must be synchronous (live)
- Time must be with a school official
- Qualify if: medical diagnoses, test positive for COVID-19, close contact

Safety & Mitigation

- Continue cleaning protocols
- Masks are encouraged in large groups and/or indoors
- Facility limitations to public when appropriate
