- Do not leave spare keys or valet keys, inside the vehicle
- Do not leave your vehicle running and unattended
- Do not leave valuables visible

Did you know?

Thieves do!

Many vehicles come equipped with side view mirrors that retract when the vehicle is locked. If the vehicle is left unlocked, the side view mirrors stick out, making it vulnerable to theft by indicating to thieves that it was left unlocked.
