

It's Time To Apply! Step Up For Students 2024 - 2025

Renewal Scholarship Students

Families with children that were already enrolled in the Step Up For Students program, may now RENEW their student's Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities, Florida Tax Credit Scholarship, or Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options for the 2024-2025 school year. As a reminder, current families who would like to renew their student's scholarship must complete the Step Up For Students application annually. For instructions on how to renew your student's scholarship, check your email or login to your Step Up For Students portal.

New Scholarship Applicants

Families may now apply for a 2024-25 scholarship for the following programs:

- Florida Tax Credit Scholarship (FTC)*
- Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO)*

• Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) *With recently passed legislation, if signed by the Governor, the Hope Scholarship will merge with the FTC and FES-EO programs. Families who are benefiting from the Hope Scholarship for the 2023-24 school year will apply through the FTC/FES-EO programs to renew their student's scholarship for the 2024-25 school year. 



(Note: if you have an account with an email already and you login with the wrong password you will get the error that this account already exists, simply reset your password and try again) Step 4: After you hit register you will come to this screen and now all you need to do is download the hallow app and login the same way you just did.
