Although CCAS serves as its own LEA, we will not make an announcement regarding our final decision until the Coweta County Board of Education finalizes their plan later this week. The delayed announcement is to ensure that our opening plans do not jeopardize a healthy community. Ellison answered and address all questions from the GCEF Board Members.
