

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

Homebound instruction is a service provided by the school district to students who are unable to attend school due to medical, emotional or disciplinary reasons. Secondary students receive instruction for two hours per day and elementary students receive one hour per day. Students receive credit for their work while on homebound instruction.

The school district makes provisions for homebound instruction upon referral from the assistant superintendent, special student services, following the guidelines established by the Superintendent of Schools for placing a student on homebound instruction.
