

TUTORING AND INDIVIDUAL HELP

While the Board of Education recognizes the professional responsibility of its staff to provide individual help to those students who may benefit from such instruction, the professional staff shall not tutor for pay or provide professional services for pay to students assigned to them. Furthermore, they may not use school district buildings when tutoring for private gain. If teachers wish to tutor for private gain after school or during the summer months, no solicitation of students to participate in such instruction is permitted in school buildings.
