

SUSPENSION – IN SCHOOL

In-school suspension must be viewed as a consequence of a student's disruptive conduct. Therefore, in order that learning take place in the classrooms of the district, an in-school suspension program which provides a continuance of instruction shall be instituted by the school district.

Parents will receive notification from the student's school regarding any in-school suspension.
