All students are required to purchase a student-parking permit. Any student who parks on school property and fails to comply with school rules and regulations will lose their parking privileges. Anyone parking without proper permits will be subject to a parking ticket issued by the local police department and may be towed AT THE EXPENSE OF THE OWNER OF THE VEHICLE. The school administration reserves the right to withdraw parking privileges from any student who has been suspended, is truant, is excessively late or cutting classes.

1. Parking permits may be obtained from the senior security aide. No duplicated permits will be allowed for a second car. If the primary car is taken off the road, the original permit must be returned to the senior security aide and a replacement permit will be issued at that time.
2. All permits must be affixed permanently to the lower corner of the front passenger windshield.
3. The senior security aide will assign a numbered spot. The student may not park anywhere else but in their designated numbered parking spot.
4. Students who park in fire lanes, handicapped parking, yellow hash lines, or any restrictive (no standing, loitering or stopping) signs will also be subject to police ticketing their vehicle and the possibility of losing their parking privileges.
5. Parking in a handicapped space will result in permanent revocation of the privilege.
6. No stopping or parking in front of the school building at any time. This area is for school buses only. All driveways nearest the building are fire lanes. These areas must be clear of vehicles at all times. No parking on grounds or sidewalks at anytime.

SCHOOL IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY THEFTS OR VANDALISM TO ANY CAR PARKED IN THE STUDENT PARKING LOT.

7. No speeding or reckless driving on school property. The 5 MPH speed limit will be strictly enforced.

8. Any student who parks in the faculty lot or the area outside the auditorium will be ticketed and will lose his/her parking permit.
9. Seniors are the only students allowed early dismissal passes. All other students are not allowed to go to their car during the day. Violators of this rule will be subject to suspension as well as loss of their parking privileges. Any student who leaves school illegally will also be subject to loss of parking privileges.
10. Students who are late more than 3 times in a marking period will have their parking permits suspended for 1 week. After lateness's the permit will be revoked for the remainder of the semester.
11. Students who are absent from school 3 times in a parking period will have their parking permits suspended for 2 weeks.
12. **STUDENTS WHO ARE SUSPENDED FROM SCHOOL FOR FIGHTING OR HAVE CHRONIC DISCIPLINE PROBLEMS WILL BE BANNED FROM PARKING FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE SCHOOL YEAR.**
13. Students who must use another car for the day **MUST GET A TEMPORARY PERMIT FROM SECURITY.**
14. No loitering in the student parking lot, or physical education area after school. Everyone with a parking permit must leave school property.
15. All East Ramapo Central School District schools are **SMOKE-FREE** schools. Any student caught smoking in school or on school property will lose their parking.
16. Students must be passing all classes in order to obtain a parking permit application.
17. In order to get a permit, you must have this form signed by your dean and senior security aide in the dean's office. Then you must submit a copy of your schedule, car registration, and driver's license to _____ for approval before a permit can be issued.
