

PARENTAL NOTIFICATION - RIGHT TO WITHHOLD CERTAIN
INFORMATION FROM MILITARY RECRUITERS
AND INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER LEARNING

Release of Certain Student Information
Under the "No Child Left Behind Act"

Pursuant to the No Child Left Behind Act, the school district must disclose to military recruiters and institutions of higher learning, upon request, the names, addresses and telephone numbers of high school students. The district must also notify parents of their right and the right of their child to request that the district not release such information without prior written parental consent.

Parents wishing to exercise their option to withhold their consent to the release of the above information to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher learning must sign and return the attached form to the building principal within 10 business days of receiving this notice.
