This font can also be used for headings. All fonts within this family can be used sparingly. The primary body copy font is **Noto Sans Light** and is also available from Adobe Fonts or Google Fonts. All fonts within this family can be used. This font should generally be **BLACK.**

The portrait version should be considered first, but the logo chosen will be determined by the nature of use and the space available.










The Bronxville 'B' is used for athletics and to show school spirit.

It may also be used where space is at a premium. In these circumstances, The Bronxville School should be well known enough that it can be recognized by a single letter.

Available in one or two colors, the two-color version below should be used where possible.

The circular versions may be used where extra definition is needed.







The Bronco mascot is also used for athletics and to show school spirit.

The mascot should primarily be used with the Bronxville 'B' attached.

If using the Bronco on it's own, Bronxville or Bronxville Broncos should appear alongside it in the Gravesend Font.

The Bronxville Promise logo highlights important traits students should strive to achieve while at school and beyond.







Most logos include a white border, so they may be used on colored backgrounds. Bronxville blue or grey should be used wherever reasonably possible.

Alternatively, a white only version of the logo is available to be used on solid blue background only.

DO NOT place logos on any other color without permission from Marketing.











Adherence to a minimum clear area around the logos helps ensure clarity of the brand.

No copy or any other graphics may encroach on this minimum space.



The minimum height of the logo is 25mm.







When presented together, all logos should be consistent in size and based on the diameter of the two circles, as shown below.
