The **North High Music Scholarship**, up to **\$500 award** to be presented each spring to a senior who has participated in music programs all four years of high school. The amount of the award may vary depending on the fund's investment performance in any given year.

This scholarship is being made possible by a gift from **Mr. John Wiese** of Davenport. His late wife, **Hanae Fujiwara Wiese**, was a music teacher in Davenport Schools for many years. She passed away in 2004. He and his family are providing this funding as a tribute to Hanae and her students.

There is no application process. Students who have participated for four years in West High School music programs, and who have maintained a 3.25 GPA or received a 24 on the ACT will be considered. Need, extra-curricular and community involvement will also be lesser considerations. Music faculty will nominate and make the final determination of scholarship awards—April 15 to DSF Scholarship Committee.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
