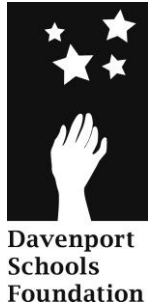

George E. Weis Career Technical Scholarship



Eligibility Information:

This up to \$500 scholarship will be granted to one graduating senior from West High School at the awards program each May. The award will go to the most deserving student as judged by the Industrial Technical Department at West High School. The amount may vary depending on the fund's investment performance in any given year.

Successful applicant will:

- Seek a formal post-high school education in a technical field. This may include education at a state-supported technical school, commercial technical school, trade union apprenticeship program, or community college.
- Complete the online application at www.davenportschools.org/foundation/scholarships/
- Assure that a letter of recommendation from a recent teacher in a non-technical class has been sent in support of the application.
- Completed applications must be submitted online before **March 1 by 11:59 P.M.**

Award:

Award is for one year only.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
