WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THIS POSITION?

This is a professional nursing position involving responsibility of giving care and treatment to students and for performing related nursing services such as pupil health appraisal and follow-through and communicable disease control requiring specialized judgement and skills. This position differs from the certified position of School Nurse-teacher in that there is no responsibility for either classroom instruction or guidance involved. The work is performed under the general direction of a school Physician or School nurse-Teacher.

WHO ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

Good knowledge of nursing principles and techniques and their relation to medical and surgical practices and skill in their application; working knowledge of material medical, dietetics, sanitation and personal hygiene; skill in the application of nursing techniques and practices; ability to understand and follow technical, oral and written instructions; ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing; ability to keep records and make reports; ability to get along well with students, teachers, parents, and others; ability to carry out successfully the therapeutic measures prescribed.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Applicants must meet all requirements described in the civil service description. Graduation from a nursing education program acceptable to the New York State Education Department (NYSED).
