

## 2024-2025 WHITE SETTLEMENT ISD DRESS GUIDELINES

ITEM	ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE	SPECIAL COMMENTS & INTERPRETATIONS
<b>Tops</b>	<p>Tops may be:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Any collared, polo or oxford-style dress shirts or knit-collared shirts</li> <li>• Sweaters, sweatshirts and hoodies. (To ensure student safety, hoods may NOT be worn in the building.)</li> <li>• T-shirts and other pullover tops</li> <li>• School designs/logos; College/Military: Brand names and any/or other appropriate words are acceptable.</li> </ul>	<p>Students are prohibited from wearing tops that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• are oversized or immodestly undersized including crop tops, tops that are tight, low-cut or show cleavage or stomach when the arms are raised.</li> <li>• depict or reference alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, nudity, gang affiliation, death, violence, vulgar/obscene language or images/insults to race, religion, gender or ethnicity, emblems/writing that could be deemed controversial/political and any emblems/writing that may cause a disruption or interference with normal school operations. * <p>Sleeveless shirts, tank tops and any tops/dresses that expose the back are not allowed.</p> </li></ul>
<b>Pants/ Bottoms</b>	<p>Pants must fit appropriately and at the waist.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Jeans</li> <li>• Shorts, skirts, skorts, capris, Dockers® or similar style pants, dress pants in denim or solid colors</li> <li>• Joggers, sweats and warm-up pants and athletic shorts</li> </ul> <p>All shorts, skirts, jumpers and skorts must be finger-tip length or longer.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Torn, cut/slashed material higher than fingertip length that reveals any area of the skin or undergarments is not allowed unless leggings are worn underneath.</li> <li>• Form-fitting garments such as leggings and spandex must be worn with an appropriate shirt, dress, skirt, jumper, etc. that is fingertip length. Shirts must fully cover the bottom. Sheer/see-through leggings/spandex are not allowed.</li> <li>• Oversized, sagging or baggy clothing is not allowed.</li> <li>• Bike shorts/spandex shorts are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<b>Dresses</b>	<p>Dresses must have sleeves and be at least finger-tip length.</p> <p>Jumpers must be finger-tip length.</p> <p>Rompers must be finger-tip length and have sleeves.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Slits/kick pleats in skirts or dresses must be modest.</li> <li>• Dresses/skirts/jumpers must meet the acceptable length requirements regardless of whether leggings are worn.</li> <li>• Pre-kindergarten through fourth grade girls must wear shorts under dresses, skirts and jumpers.</li> </ul>
<b>Shoes</b>	<p>Shoes should be worn that enhance the student's safety.</p> <p>Students participating in PE/athletics must wear athletic footwear to participate.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maximum shoe height is 2 inches for students in grades pre-kindergarten through 4.</li> <li>• Shoes over 2 inches are not recommended for all other grade levels for safety reasons.</li> <li>• Flip flops, aqua socks and non-athletic toe shoes, slippers, house shoes, skate shoes and Heelies® are not allowed.</li> </ul>
<b>Jewelry/ Accessories</b>	<p>Jewelry/accessories cannot be a safety hazard.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Fishnet hosiery/clothing is not allowed.</li> <li>• Gages in ears must be plugged.</li> <li>• Hoods, hats, caps, visors, head coverings, do-rags, bandannas, sweatbands and sunglasses are not allowed in the building.</li> <li>• Any jewelry, accessories, tattoos that contain vulgar, obscene or offensive images are not allowed (See paragraph in Tops above). *</li> </ul>
<b>IDs</b>	<p>Brewer High and Brewer Middle School students must wear school IDs at all times.</p>	

Administrative discretion will be given for all dress guideline decisions. Anything deemed to be distracting in the classroom/school environment will not be allowed.
