

GRANT SUPPORT

Capital Area Intermediate Unit



Arts in Education grant funding varies between 30-50% and is determined by the length of the residency. This includes daily artist fees, artist travel (*if applicable*), supplies and other materials needed to complete the residency, and an administrative fee.

The following table lists examples summarizing how residencies are funded by the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts (PCA). There is a **5-day minimum for company/ensemble residencies** and a **20-day minimum for individual artist residencies** to receive a 1:1 match.

5-14 days	70%	\$2,000	\$200	\$2,200	\$600	\$1,600

20+ days	50%	\$4,000	\$400	\$4,400	\$2,000	\$2,400

*The Total Residency Cost is based on a \$230/day (*community-based residency*) and \$250-day (*school-based residency*) artist fee.
Note: Artists' fees vary. The above rates are samples only.
