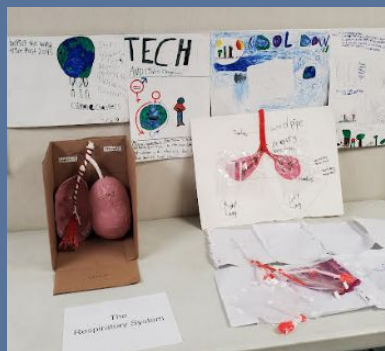
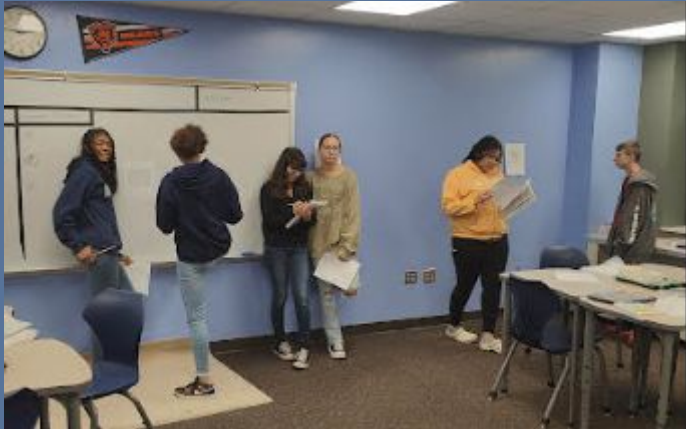
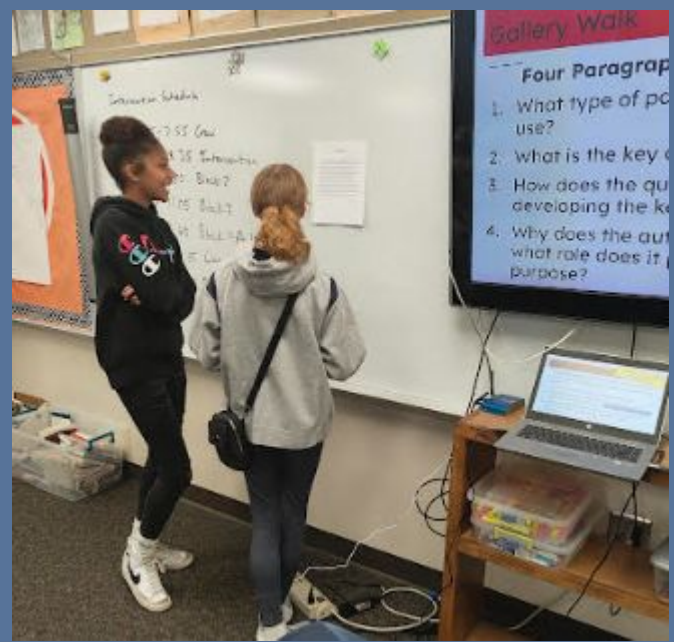
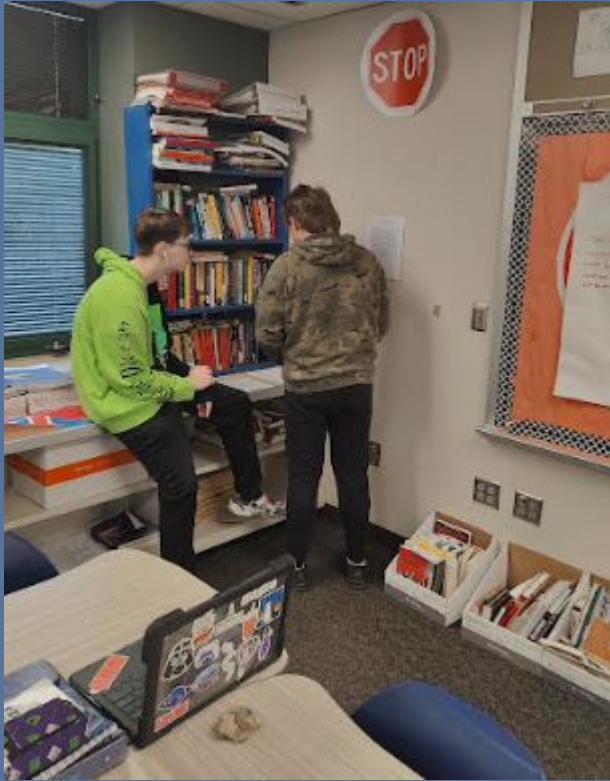
AP testing forms are due soon! If you are unsure if you are signed up for your test, check with your AP teacher. Be sure to fill out the AP survey!

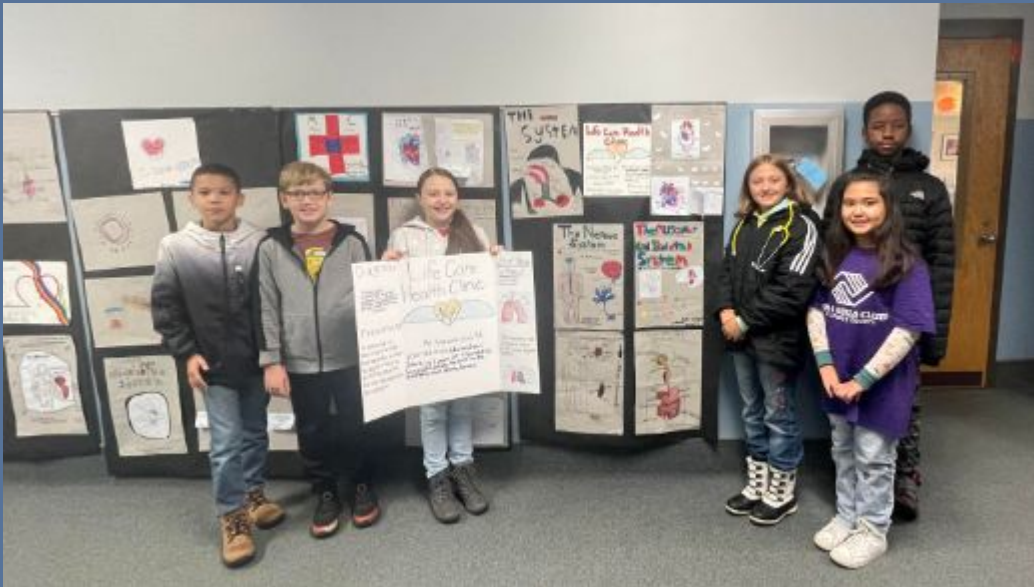
