

NEW VOLUNTEER/CHAPERONE PROCESS

Kingsburg Elementary Charter School District is excited to announce a new and streamlined process for becoming a volunteer or chaperone in our schools. Your involvement and support play a vital role in ensuring the safety of our students and enriching their education. **Even if you are a current cleared volunteer, you will need to go through this process.** This process is best completed using a laptop/desktop computer. Please follow the steps outlined below to become an approved volunteer or chaperone:

1. READ AND SIGN THE EXPECTATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR VOLUNTEERS AND CHAPERONES:

2. CHILD ABUSE MANDATED REPORTER ONLINE TRAINING

- All volunteers and chaperones must complete the **CA Child Abuse Mandated Reporter training** for volunteers (required by CA Assembly Bill 506). This online course is designed to help you understand your role in recognizing and reporting child abuse.
- Once the training is completed, print or download the certificate showing completion.

3. NEGATIVE TB TEST OR TB RISK ASSESSMENT

A negative TB test or a completed **TB Risk Assessment** is required to ensure the health and safety of our school community. Please visit your healthcare provider or a local clinic to obtain this documentation.

4. ONLINE APPLICATION THROUGH RAPTOR TECHNOLOGIES

We are utilizing Raptor Technologies to manage our volunteer and chaperone applications. Please visit **Raptor Technologies** to complete the online application. This system helps us keep track of volunteer activities and ensures all necessary requirements are met.

Once your application is complete and the required documents are uploaded and verified, you will be notified via email if your application has been approved. Once approved, you will be cleared to work in the classroom or be a field trip chaperone.
