Official notice will also be given to radio station WBEN AM (930). In addition, every household will receive an automated telephone call. Occasionally, weather conditions become severe after the school day has begun, necessitating an early dismissal. Since the early dismissals cannot be foreseen, parents/guardians are reminded that children need a definite place to go if they are released at midday. Make arrangements now to be sure that your child knows what to do and where to go if they are released early from school.
