

Application for Free/Discounted District Fees

The family income survey (below) is used to determine household eligibility for free or discounted fees related to specific school activities, athletics or programs. A specific list of programs and fees can be found on your school's website. The information that you provide is voluntary and will be treated confidentially and is intended for school district use only. To be eligible, this information needs to be submitted every year.

Household size is defined as all persons — including parents, children, grandparents and all people related or unrelated — who live in your home and share living expenses. If you're applying for a household with a foster child, you may include the foster child in the total household size.

Household income is considered to be any taxable income each household member received before taxes. This includes all wages, social security benefits, pension, unemployment benefits, welfare payments, child support, alimony and any other cash income. Do not include foster care payments as income.
