**SUMMER REC SOCCER** is the largest program for youth in the area. This summer we will have almost 900 kids, age 4 through 8th grade, enrolled in the five-week session. This program has grown over the years and is successful because of the partnerships with volunteer coaches and parents. Each week teams play on 12 small fields and 6 large fields at the D.C. Everest Middle School Soccer Complex. Players learn basic rules of soccer, positions, foot coordination and team play.


# COACH



# RENTAL RATES

#### **Turf**

The arena has a full-size turf field sectioned into four (4) fields each 30 X 70 yards. Each field will rent for \$100/hour per field. All renters will use the online portal REC DESK or contact the Facility Scheduling Coordinator.



### **Meeting Rooms**

There are four (4) meeting rooms available in GTCC. Rooms will rent for \$25/hour and should be coordinated through the Facility Scheduling Coordinator.



### **Walking Lanes**

Walking lanes will be open most days from 7:00 am-8:00 pm when the front desk is staffed. A valid GTCC membership badge must be on file and scanned. Due to supply chain issues, the rubber track surface has been delayed. It will be installed later in 2024. One mile will equal four (4) laps. The walking track is included in a fitness center membership or a day pass may be purchased for use.



# **Sport Simulators**

The simulators will be available to rent for \$40/hour. The wide-screen simulators are available to play a variety of sports. The simulators measure your ball at impact with an overhead ION3 Camera and inflight with a combination of infrared technology & high-speed blue light LED cameras to show your real ball flight, with no delay, for the most realistic ball flight on the market. The simulators are available to play 13 sports including baseball, soccer, zombie dodgeball and much more.
