- Assist the president and board in creating a buzz about the Academy that will cause stakeholders to want to contribute to on-going success.
- Create the vision for and lead all fundraising and development initiatives.
- Visit with and listen to prospective donors, and help them envision their potential positive impact on MMA cadets and families through scholarship funding and other Academy support.
- Plan and present naming opportunities based on a prospect's capacity to give.
- Lead and manage an administrative assistant/research and database specialist.
- Support on and off-campus events with Academy staff, seek event sponsorships, and coordinate with Alumni Association Board.

- Plan, advertise, and execute the annual fund campaign, Maroon & Gold Gala (in coordination with Alumni Association Board), and support business/athletic fund campaign, and in time, a major capital campaign.
- Serve as the president's liaison with the Board of Trustees Development Committee.
- Work with and seek advice and counsel from the Board of Trustees Development Committee on prospective donors, foundations, community, and other contacts.
- Support president and spouse as requested during alumni/parent/donor social events on campus and at the president's home.
- Periodically work after normal duty hours in the evening and on weekends with frequent travel.

Missouri Military Academy is an all-male, college preparatory military boarding school (middle school and high school) with a diverse domestic and international student population. Program of studies: 4x4 block schedule requires cadets to take four courses each semester, enabling cadets to take eight courses every school year; Triumph Program with William Woods University enables qualified cadets to earn college credit and work toward associate degree while in high school. Army JROTC is mandatory for all cadets.

Extracurricular activities: 13 varsity sports, plus junior varsity and middle school athletics; Army JROTC Fusileers drill, Raiders and rifle teams; Boy Scouts of America; equestrian; Future Business Leaders of America; marching and jazz band; choir; rappelling; paintball; camping; fishing; obstacle course; hiking trails and more.

Campus size: 288 acres. 316,063 sq. ft. of building space, with 33 classrooms. View campus.

Location: Mexico, Missouri, a community of approximately 11,000 residents. MMA is approximately 2 hours from St. Louis, MO; 2.5 hours from Kansas City, MO; and 45 minutes from Columbia, MO, home of the University of Missouri.

College acceptance rate: 100%. The Class of 2024 was offered more than \$4.9 million in college scholarships.
