## SUSD Transfer Student Lower Level Declaration

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2023, the AIA Legislative Council passed a new AIA bylaw that affects transferring student athletes. Bylaw **15.10.1.1.2** (<https://aiaonline.org/files/65/article-15-student-eligibility-rules.pdf>) states that “a transfer student who plays only in sub-varsity competitions shall have immediate eligibility but is ineligible to participate at the varsity level in regular season and post-season competitions for the season in that sport. A decision to participate only at sub-varsity levels must be made prior to the season of competition.”

This means that a student-athlete who has competed for any other high school in the previous 12 months and has subsequently transferred (enrolled) in a new school has the following two options:

By signing this document, I acknowledge and understand that my son/daughter/athlete will not be eligible to compete, or suit up, in any varsity regular season, tournament, or postseason competition. Also, I understand I am not able to change this decision after the season of competition begins.
