



Off-Campus Physical Education (OCPE)

F.A.Q.'s

- 1. How do I know if my student's OCPE provider is approved by the School Board and on the district's approved providers list?**

The district will post the provider list in May, once the list of OCPE providers has been approved by the school board; this approval process happens annually. The providers must submit copies of their professional licenses to train and/or proof that they are capable of this high level of intense training.

- 2. What if my student's provider is not on your approved provider list?**

Please have your provider call the District Student Services Coordinator at (469) 742 - 9100 x 1125 to acquire information about becoming a Celina ISD approved OCPE Provider.

- 3. How many hours must a student be in practice every day?**

The number of hours must add up to 5 or 15 hours depending upon the requested category. The number of hours must be spread over 5 days a week. The student must participate a minimum of four (4) days during the week (Monday through Friday) plus one (1) additional day that may fall on either the weekend or during the week for a total of five (5) days per week.

- 4. Is travel time included as part of the time requirement?**

No, the student should not include travel time as part of the time requirement. Also, if a student works at the facility he/she may not count work hours towards the time requirement.

- 5. Can the student have more than ONE Provider/Activity?**

No, only 1 Provider/Activity may be selected for OCPE. Credit will not be given for a combination of hours.

- 6. May the student enroll in the OCPE program for part of the semester?**

Participation must run concurrently with the school calendar and continue throughout the entire semester.

- 7. Can the student include tournament play/competitions per week be included in the time requirements?**

No more than 6 hours of tournament/competitions per week may be included in the time requirements for Category ONE - 15 hours / week.
