WHAT IS THE FAFSA?

Free Application for Federal Student Aid – FAFSA

Serves as application for federal and state financial aid programs

- Pell Grant
- Federal Work Study
- Federal Student Loans
- HOPE/Zell Miller Scholarships and Grants

Annual application opens every October 1. <u>https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa</u>



FSA ID



WHAT IS AN FSA ID?

Serves as log in for all federal education websites, including FAFSA.

Allows utilization of IRS Data Retrieval on FAFSA

Both student and 1 parent need to create their own FSA ID. (Parent may have existing FSA ID from their own prior student status or a prior dependent child's FAFSA

WHAT IS NEEDED TO CREATE AN FSA ID

Social Security Card

- Use Correct SSN (No Tax ID Number)
- Name as it appears on SSC
- Correct Date of Birth
- Personal email and cell phone number

TIPS FOR SUCCESS - STATUS

Status Questions – These statuses require 3rd party documentation (i.e. court documents, DFACS)

Emancipated Minor

Ward of the Court

Legal Guardianship (Not Custody)

Foster Care

Orphan

Homelessness

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TIPS FOR SUCCESS – PARENT MARITAL STATUS

Which Parent(s) is included on the FAFSA? Parent(s) student lived with majority of time during last 12 months. Does NOT have to match tax return claimed dependent.

Biological/Legally Adoptive parents are the responsible parent to be included. *Marital status as of date completing FAFSA*.

- Married both parents data
- Unmarried living together both parents data
- Separated/Divorced data for parent who provides housing for student
- Divorced parent who has remarried parent and stepparent data
- Single/Divorced parent with significant other parent data only



TIPS FOR SUCCESS – PARENTS WITH NO SSN

- Parents with no SSN cannot create an FSA ID
- Must print and sign FAFSA signature sheet (If GGC applicant, our office will process the signature page)
- Parents with no SSN input all zeros (000-00-0000) on FAFSA



PROFESSIONAL JUDGEMENTS

Dependency Override

- Students with a documentable break in relationship with parents (abuse/abandonment/neglect).
- Complete FAFSA with student data only/select unable to provide parent data/Special Circumstance
- Contact Financial Aid Office for instructions


Financial Appeal

- Families who have documentable reduction in income since 2021
