

CLASSROOM DRESS CODE Quick Guide all students grades prek-12







All bottoms must be worn at the waist line.

BELTS, SHOES, & ACCESSORIES

Belts must be the appropriate length for the student's waist size. Belt buckles must be plain, standard style.

All shoes shall consist of a closed back and front.

No sandals, wedged soles, platforms, high heels, "crocs," slippers, shower shoes, flip flops, moccasins or kneehigh shoes shall be allowed.

> Students may only wear stud earrings. Piercings other than in the ear are not allowed.

Khaki or navy color twill "slacks" & shorts with or without pleats, with or without pockets, with or without belt loops (if belt loops, students <u>must</u> wear a belt) will be no more than 3 inches above the knee.

Remember, school uniforms must:

- be solid in color
- fit properly for normal daily activity
- be clean and free of tears/rips/holes
- have tucked shirt tails if requested by principal

NOTE ABOUT COATS



Students may wear heavy coats or jackets of any color or style outdoors and on school buses; however, said coats/jackets may not have inappropriate insignia, logos, or language. Dusters or trench coats are not allowed.

Heavy coats/jackets/hats must be removed upon entering a school building.. No hoodies allowed on school campuses or busses.

TPSS students and families are to use good judgment in overall appearance so that the attention of others is not distracted from the purpose of the school. Cleanliness and the values of the community shall be a basic consideration. Attire should not disrupt the classroom and/or the school's positive learning environment.
