<u>The Request for Proposal is due, Friday, May 3, 2024, @ 2:30 p.m.</u> There will not be a formal Proposal opening. Please submit Proposal as required in the general conditions, instructions and information.

The contract period to furnish transportation services is for four (4) years starting June 1, 2024, through the last day of school May 31, 2028. At the conclusion of the four year period, a rollover year may be granted as a one year extension, each year for up to four years ending May 31, 2032.

The services shall consist of the furnishing school bus transportation as required for students and other persons designated by the District to and from designated schools operated by the District, and/or to and from points as directed; such transportation to be furnished by means of buses herein specified and at such times and places as shall be specified by the District.

The General Conditions, Instructions, and Information that are a part of this Request for Proposal will be incorporated into the contract. The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any one or all proposals received and to waive any technicalities.

The original and three (3) copies of this proposal shall be the submission requirement.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR PAPILLION LA VISTA COMMUNITY SCHOOLS PAPILLION, NEBRASKA

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GENERAL CONDITIONS, INSTRUCTIONS AND INFORMATION

1. TERM

The period covered by the Proposal is for four (4) school years beginning on June 1, 2024, through the last day of school May 31, 2028. At the conclusion of the four year period, a rollover year may be granted as a one year extension, each year for up to four years, ending May 31, 2032. Provided, however, that parties shall have the option to terminate the Contract without cause at the end of the current school year with 90 days written notice to the other party.

2. INDEMNIFICATION - The Contractor agrees:

- a. To hold the District, its Board, Officers and Agents harmless and fully indemnify and defend said District, its Board, Officers and Agents and its employees from all damages or claims for damages, costs of expenses in law or equity arising out of or in any way resulting from this Contract and the performance hereof except to the extent that such claim or demand arises from or is caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of district, its agents or employees.
- b. To save, keep, hold harmless, fully indemnify and defend the District, its Board, Officers and Agents and its employees from all damages or claims for damages, costs or expenses in law or equity that may at any time arise or be claims for an infringement of the patent rights, copyright or trademark of any person or persons in consequence of the use in the performance of this Contract of any article of which the Contractor is not the patentee or assignee or has not the lawful right to use except to the extent that such claim or demand arises from or is caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of District, its agents or employees.
- c. To hold harmless, indemnify and defend the District, its Board, Officers and Agents and its employees from and against any and all loss, damage, injury, liability and claims made for damage, expense or loss arising out of or in any way resulting from the performance of its duties hereunder except to the extent that such claim or demand arises from or is caused by the negligence or willful misconduct of District, its agents or employees.

3. CIVIL RIGHTS

Contractor agrees to comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (P.L. 88352) and all requirements imposed by or pursuant to the Regulations of the Department of Education (34 C.F.R. Part 100) issued pursuant to that title, to the end that, in accordance with Title VI of that Act and the Regulation, no person in the United States shall on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the Applicant receives federal financial assistance from the Department; and hereby gives assurance that all measures necessary to immediately effectuate this agreement will be taken. The Contractor further agrees to comply with all applicable requirements of state and local laws, ordinances and regulations regarding nondiscrimination in employment.

4. INSURANCE

Contractor shall furnish evidence of insurance covering all contractual liability and obligations assumed herein, and all of its operations under this Contract, in a form and with companies acceptable to the District as follows:

Base Coverage

a. Comprehensive general liability insurance including broad form property contractual liability and personal injury insurance for claims arising under this claim:

\$1,000,000 per occurrence. \$2,000,000 annual aggregate, single limit, covering bodily injuries, property damage and personal injury.

b. Comprehensive automobile liability insurance, including owned, non-owned and hired vehicles (including buses):

\$1,000,000 per occurrence, no annual aggregate, single limit, covering bodily injuries and property damage.

c. \$5,000,000 per occurrence liability umbrella.

Umbrella Coverage

\$20,000,000 per occurrence, single limit, covering bodily injuries, property damage and personal injury.

The base coverage shall have no annual aggregate limit, and the total coverage shall be \$21,000,000. Umbrella coverage shall cover at least all risks insured under the base coverage. Insurance shall provide coverage for passengers from the time that they are delivered into custody of Contractor, or the custody of Contractor's employees, when being picked up at home or at school, until Contractor or Contractor's employees release them to the school or District approved and designated bus stop location. Contractor shall also maintain statutory worker's compensation coverage for all of its employees. Satisfactory evidence of above insurance shall be provided by Contractor to the District. There are no exceptions to this requirement. Contractor shall furnish contractual liability coverage endorsement with the same levels of coverage for each claim as shown herein to cover all contractual liability assumed herein. Contractor shall not commence work under this Contract until all insurance required under this section has been obtained and approved by the District. Approval of the insurance by the District shall not relieve or decrease the liability of Contractor hereunder. On all insurance coverage, insurance endorsement shall require thirty (30) days advance notice to the District in the event of cancellation or material change in the coverage. District shall be named as an additional insured on all liability policies as referenced. In the event Contractor fails to maintain insurance as required herein, District may, but shall not be obligated to, obtain such coverage and the cost thereof shall be deducted from any amounts owed Contractor hereunder.

5. LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Equipment and services covered by this Contract must initially comply with and continue to comply with all applicable laws, ordinances and other legal requirements, including (among others) Nebraska Rules and Regulations, Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 91, Regulations governing Driver Qualifications and Operational Procedures for Pupil Transportation Vehicles and Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 92, Regulations Governing the Minimum Equipment Standards and Safety Inspection Criteria for Pupil Transportation Vehicles and amendments thereto, the pertinent provisions of the Nebraska Motor Vehicle Code, Policies and Regulations of the District, regulations of the City of Papillion, City of La Vista, City of Bellevue, and the State of Nebraska as amended, during the entire term of this Agreement.

6. PAYMENT

Payment will be made by the District to the Contractor monthly in arrears as charges accrue after receipt of properly documented invoices and statements. Invoices and statements must be received at 420 South Washington Street, Papillion, NE 68046, not later than the 15th of each month for payment in the following month.

7. SCOPE OF THE REQUIREMENT

Papillon La Vista Community Schools is requesting a proposal for Contract busing for four (4) school years starting June 1, 2024, and ending May 31, 2028, for the requirements listed below:

- a. Daily (AM) and (PM) transportation for a total of nineteen (19) routes using 19 buses. We estimate a minimum five-hour route/travel time per day. If service requirements change, the District reserves the right to require transportation services for additional routes. If additional services are required, Contractor shall have ten (10) days to provide said services. District may increase or decrease services to be provided by Contractor under this Agreement. However, where such increase or decreases materially impact the service levels or equipment levels required by the contractor under assumed routes, schedules, and vehicle requirements contained in this Agreement, Contractor shall be permitted to adjust rates at which services are provided to cover increases or decreases in cost structure associated with such changes by the District.
- b. Contractor will provide all resources necessary to implement and sustain the scope of this requirement.

c. Routing and Scheduling of Buses

Contractor shall provide routing services, defined as providing routing software, designing bus routes, assigning riders, pairing or packaging bus routes, and/or optimizing accordingly. Routes shall be submitted to the district for approval at least 14 days prior to implementation. The Contractor drivers shall not deviate from the approved routes. Contractor shall furnish each driver and the District with a typed or electronic route itinerary that includes all pickup locations, times, directions between pickups and schools, as well as student names at their designated pickup spot. A current route itinerary should be on the bus at all times while transporting students. Routes and schedules can only be altered by

written approval of the District. Contractor shall provide load counts, mileage, and all other documentation required to complete state statistical reports.

Contractor shall cooperate with the District in maintaining a good public relations program with the community and news media so that any pertinent items affecting the transportation program, or the patrons of the District can be brought to the attention of the public. Buses shall be scheduled to arrive at the designated location within the District no earlier than 10 minutes and no later than 5 minutes from the scheduled time. Students shall be picked up at the designated District location for the return trip home no later than 10 minutes after the designated departure time. Contractor shall operate routes according to instruction and time schedules provided by the District. Contractor shall provide within 14 days of any request, those reports and records which may be reasonably requested by District pertaining to students, routes, stops, mileage audits and other information having to do with daily operations.

In reviewing Contractor's records, District shall protect the confidentiality of Contractor's proprietary or confidential information included in the data provided. Contractor shall maintain such records and submit such reports, as are deemed necessary by the District and as negotiated between Contractor and District from time to time. All reports required by District shall be submitted on forms mutually agreed upon by both parties. Contractor will not be responsible for filing on behalf of District any state or regulatory reports concerning ridership or reimbursement.

Contractor may be required to transport additional students as determined by the District. The Contractor will be obligated to transport said students provided a three (3) day notice is given by the District.

District may increase or decrease services to be provided by Contractor under this Agreement. However, where such increases or decreases materially impact the service levels or equipment levels required by Contractor under the assumed routes, schedules, and vehicle requirements contained in this Agreement; Contractor shall be permitted to adjust rates as per Contract for services provided to cover increases or decreases in cost structure associated with such changes by the District.

8. EQUIPMENT REQUIREMENTS

Inspection and Maintenance of Buses

Contractor shall keep and maintain all buses in good operating and running condition, and in a clean and sanitary condition, and in order to insure the same, Contractor will make buses available within three (3) days upon written request for inspection at an agreed upon location. Contractor shall not operate any bus under this Contract which is more than seven (7) years old from build date, with an average fleet age of five (5) years.

Contractor shall maintain an approved state inspection and preventative maintenance program which meets or exceeds all applicable federal and state laws, ordinances, regulations, rules, and guidelines. All buses shall be equipped with live GPS capable of recording and tracking a buses'

location and speed. The district shall have access to the GPS system at all times while transporting students.

In the event that District or any governmental agency imposes additional equipment requirements other than those set forth above on Contractor's vehicles during the term of this Agreement; which are specific requirements for the operation of this Contract; or immediate installation is required for continuing operation of the vehicles, Contractor and District shall negotiate in good faith concerning price increases applicable to such equipment installation.

In the event, at any time, the District determines that Contractor has not performed any required state inspection or preventative maintenance, or has not maintained any such bus, or has not kept such vehicle clean and sanitary, or in the event the District determines that any such bus has not been maintained, is unsafe, or does not comply with applicable federal and state laws, ordinances, regulations, rules, and guidelines for the Contractor then, in addition, all other remedies for default provided under the Contract; the District may require that such vehicle be removed from service by the Contractor. In such event, Contractor shall not return such vehicle to service until all such deficiencies have been corrected to the satisfaction of the District.

9. IDENTIFICATION

Contractor shall provide the District a list of bus identification numbers for those buses assigned to fulfill the Contract requirements. When using a bus other than the assigned bus, the assigned bus number will be clearly displayed in the right, side window, or the right side of the bus closest to the entry/exit door.

10. DRIVER AND PERSONNEL QUALIFICATIONS

Contractor shall provide qualified drivers for each vehicle employed. Contractor will also ensure an adequate number of "substitute" drivers are available in the event the primary driver is absent. Contractor shall ensure all drivers tasked to fulfill the obligations of Contract are trained and licensed in accordance with the Nebraska Rules and Regulations, Title 92, Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 91, Regulations Governing Driver Qualifications and Operational Procedures for Pupil Transportation Vehicles and any amendments thereto, and any applicable federal rules, regulations and guidelines and amendments or supplanting enactments thereto. Contractor shall investigate the driving record (including driver offenses and accidents) and any criminal convictions of all applicants for driver positions to determine if such applicants are fit to perform the duties of a bus driver. Contractor shall also meet all requirements for drug and alcohol testing promulgated under applicable governmental law, ordinance or regulation, including but not limited to all Federal Department of Transportation and Federal Highway Amendment requirements pertaining thereto, including all amendments thereto. In addition:

a. All drivers must have a valid Commercial Driver's License with an endorsement for School Bus Driver and Passenger, and undergo an annual physical examination including screening for drug and alcohol use, as required by law. Any, and all documentation validating driver's

qualifications and physical fitness must be made available to the District within 24 hours of request by the District.

b. Contractor shall have full responsibility for student transportation as a specialized function, the essence of which is for students to be transported regularly, promptly, safely and without interruption or incident. Contractor acknowledges that the interests of the students take precedence over the interests of the Contractor, the Contractor's drivers and other personnel. Drivers and all other persons having contact with students shall be of stable personality and of good moral character. The District places upon Contractor full responsibility to ensure such qualities in those persons. To the best of its ability, Contractor shall not allow any person to drive a school bus whose behavior or character might result in improper performance of his or her work or subject the student to improper driver conduct, whatsoever, nor shall the Contractor allow any person to drive a school bus who is not at the time physically fit and physically qualified to perform such service.

Contractor shall take reasonable steps to prevent its employees from exposing any students to impropriety of word or conduct. Contractor shall not knowingly permit its drivers to smoke on the bus, to drink any intoxication beverage, or to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol while operating any bus. Contractor shall at all times abide by applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations in its hiring practices.

- c. Prior to actual service as a driver on any Papillion La Vista Public Schools contracted route, each employee must be knowledgeable of District procedures as they relate to transportation of students, school locations, pick-up and drop-off procedures, and student discipline.
- d. All drivers shall be completely familiar with their routes prior to actual route operation with students on board.
- e. The responsibility for hiring and discharging Contractor personnel shall rest entirely upon Contractor, and Contractor agrees that it shall not enter into any agreement or arrangement with any employee, person, group or organization which will, in any way, interfere with Contractor's ability to comply to the full extent of the Contract with the District and the requirements contained herein. Contractor further agrees that the District shall have the right to REQUIRE removal by Contractor of any person or driver, who, in the opinion of the District, is not qualified for or satisfactorily performing, the responsibilities of the position held or to operate a school bus for service to the standards required by the District. The District will provide written request to remove Contractor employee with notation for the reason for such removal.

11. STUDENT TRACKING

Contractor shall equip all buses, if the District were to request, a student tracking system to accurately identify ridership in real-time. The purchase, installation and maintenance of the system shall be solely Contractor's responsibility. The District will provide proximity cards if

required. Access to the system must be provided to District personnel for locating students based on badge scans.

12. SAFETY PROGRAM

Contractor shall comply with all requirements of Nebraska laws governing the safe operation of school bus equipment and training of personnel as it relates to the safety of students transported for the District.

Route times shall be scheduled through mutual agreements between the District and the Contractor to provide for semiannual emergency exit drills as required.

13. PUPIL DISCIPLINE

Contractor shall recognize its responsibility to the District for the maintenance of proper pupil discipline as an inherent factor to the safety of all persons aboard a school bus. The driver is to be primarily a reporting agent, only, and is not to perform physical acts of discipline.

The following guidelines (among others) shall be of assistance to drivers employed by Contractor in determining procedures to be followed in maintaining acceptable pupil discipline.

- a. Bus drivers shall have delegated responsibility for maintaining proper discipline on their bus.
- b. Pupil behavior problems which develop on the bus, will be reported in a written form to be delivered to the school building principal of the building at which the pupil attends. The written report to be delivered no later than the duty day following an incident.
- c. The bus driver is <u>not</u> authorized to remove pupils from the bus. If a pupil is endangering the safety of other riders, the bus driver should stop the bus and call for assistance. Contractor shall notify District as soon as possible.
- d. Contractor shall provide for meetings of individual drivers with District authorities as requested.

14. UNSCHEDULED SCHOOL CLOSING

The District shall not be obligated to accept or pay for standby services of Contractor on those days when the schools of the District are closed to insure the health or safety of the pupils. Papillion La Vista Community Schools shall make the decision as to the need for closing no later than the start of the school day.

Contractor shall agree to operate during snow or ice conditions and will provide for appropriate equipment and trained personnel; and will implement alternate bus routes as necessary and approved by the District under such conditions.

14. UNSCHEDULED SCHOOL CLOSING - continued

The District shall notify the Contractor of canceled special bus trips not less than one (1) hour prior to the first scheduled pick up per trip. If the District fails to give the Contractor one (1) hour notification of canceled special trips, the District shall pay the Contractor for the driver's actual time.

15. FORCE MAJEURE

The parties to the Agreement shall be excused from performance hereunder during the time and to the extent that they are prevented from performing in the customary manner by act of God, fire, strike, loss of transportation facilities, lockout, unavailability or commandeering of materials, products, plants or facilities by the Government; or rationing or limitation of use of materials or products, when satisfactory evidence thereof is presented to the other party, provided that it is satisfactorily established that the nonperformance is not due to the fault or neglect of the party not performing. However, in the event Contractor cannot fully perform its services hereunder due to any of the causes enumerated in this Paragraph, District may, without terminating the Agreement and so long as Contractor cannot provide such full services, or provide such services by another contractor, the cost thereof shall be deducted from any amounts due or to become due to Contractor during the term of the Contract, if any. In the event the cost of such substituted services exceeds the amount due or to become due Contractor, then Contractor and Contractor's surety shall reimburse District for the excess cost of such substitute services. Such substitute service shall not relieve Contractor of its obligation to provide such services with its own personnel and equipment after such cause no longer exists.

In the event Contractor is unable to provide the transportation services as specified in this Agreement because of any act of civil disturbance riot, war, terrorism, picketing, labor dispute, labor shortages, governmental action or any other condition or cause beyond the Contractor's control, District shall excuse Contractor from performance under this Agreement.

16. SAVINGS CLAUSE

The Contractor and District hereto agree that in the event any provisions specified in the contract are finally held or determined to be illegal or void as being in violation of any applicable law, the remainder of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

17. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES/MISSED SERVICE CHARGES

In the event Contractor is late in performing a service, adjustments to the charge will be made. Except when caused by traffic congestion, discipline problems, mechanical breakdowns during the route, or Force Majeure (Section 14), Contractor will be charged late charges as follows for late buses:

30 minutes or more

Missed Trip

Should a trip be missed entirely, Contractor shall be charged an amount equivalent to 1.5 times of the daily Contract rate for the trip. In the event Contractor utilizes a single bus to cover two

routes ("doubled route"), District shall only be charged for one route. The other route will be considered a "missed trip". The Contractor shall report to District, and on a daily basis, as soon as reasonably practical, all missed, late and doubled routes. All charges against Contractor shall be deducted from monthly Contract payments due Contractor under this Contract. Contractor shall immediately notify the District and the school involved in the event of delay. If pupils are missed as a result of the bus being off schedule, Contractor agrees, at his own expense, to pick up and deliver missed pupils in a timely manner. The late charges set forth herein are in addition to all other remedies that District has in the event of default.

18. ASSIGNMENT

The services contemplated by the District are deemed to be in the nature of personal services and the Contract shall not be assigned in whole or in part by Contractor without prior written consent of the District, nor is Contractor granted the right to assign any funds to be received hereunder. District's consent to assign shall not be reasonably withheld or delayed. Contractor may assign this Agreement if the assignment is made to a parent, subsidiary, related or affiliated company.

19. VEHICLE SPECIFICATION

Buses provided herein meet or exceed Nebraska Rules and Regulations, Title 92, Nebraska Department of Education, Chapter 93, Nebraska Minimum Equipment Standards for School Transportation Vehicles, and all amendments thereto. All buses should be equipped with cameras for recorded viewing. Contractor shall not operate any bus under this contract which is more than seven (7) years old from build date, with an average fleet age of five (5) years.

20. MINIMUM STAFFING BY CONTRACTOR

The Contractor will provide a local supervisor who will be the point of contact for operation of the bus routes and will act as a customer service liaison between the District, the drivers, and the Contractor. The Contractor shall provide the ability for the District to contact a person who is able to provide real-time contact and information regarding buses that are on route or reasonably should be on route in support of Contract.

21. RECORDS AND ACCIDENT REPORTS

Contractor shall be required to provide those reports and records deemed necessary by the District for proper knowledge of, and evaluation of, the transportation services provided to the District. Contractor shall provide District with all necessary information as required by the State of Nebraska annual transportation report. Contractor shall notify the District immediately by telephone of any vehicle accident or student injury. Contractor shall forward within 24 hours of each accident involving injury, a written report describing all details of such accident. All other accident reports shall be submitted within 48 hours.

22. SERVICE ADJUSTMENTS – NUMBER OF VEHICLES

The District reserves the right during the Contract period, to order the services of <u>MORE</u> or <u>FEWER</u> bus vehicles, each with a driver, than the estimated numbers recorded herein, and to revise the numbers of pupils assigned to each bus vehicle and the schools to be served as conditions require. District will give Contractor ten (10) days written notice for service adjustments which require additional buses.

23. VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS

All contracted buses will have a capacity of 65 or more passengers unless a smaller capacity bus is requested by Contractor and approved by the District. The District will provide ten (10) days notice in the event a larger capacity bus is required. A minimum of two (2) wheelchair accessible buses must be available. All buses should be equipped with cameras for recorded viewing.

24. EXCLUSION OF PERSONS WITH CRIMINAL RECORDS

Papillion La Vista Community Schools requires, and Contractor agrees, to not assign any individual or agent to any work under this Contract with a criminal conviction of a serious nature, to include, but not limited to: (a) a felony; (b) any conviction of a sexual nature; (c) DUI/DWI within the last ten (10) years; (d) any conviction involving drugs or alcohol; (e) any traffic violation or series of traffic violations which resulted in the loss of a Commercial Driver's License at any time. Contractor authorizes and gives consent, and agrees to cooperate in obtaining any additional authorization or consent necessary to assure compliance with this requirement; to actively continue and implement this policy throughout the Contract period and to require implementation of this policy by any subcontractors and/or agents involved by Contractor in the performance of the Contract.

25. NEW EMPLOYEE WORK ELIGIBILTY STATUS

Contractor is required and hereby agrees to use a federal immigration verification system to determine the work eligibility status of new employees physically performing services within the State of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program authorized by the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the EOVerify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee.

If Contractor is an individual or sole proprietorship, the following applies:

- 1. Contractor must complete the United States Citizenship Attestation Form, available on the Department of Administrative Services website at www.das.state.ne.us
- 2. If Contractor indicates on such attestation form that he or she is a qualified alien, Contractor agrees to provide the US Citizenship and Immigration Services documentation

required to verify Contractor's lawful presence in the United States using the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) Program.

3. Contractor understands and agrees that lawful presence in the United States is required and Contractor may be disqualified or the Contract terminated if such lawful presence cannot be verified as required by Neb. Rev. Stat. €4-108.

26. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

The parties shall negotiate in good faith in an attempt to resolve any dispute that may arise under this Agreement. Disputes that cannot be resolved by negotiation shall be submitted to mediation, using a mutually agreed upon mediator. In the absence of an agreement on a mediator, each party shall select a temporary mediator and those mediators shall jointly select the permanent mediator. If mediation is not successful, the parties may pursue their remedies as they choose. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to prevent the parties from agreeing in the future to submit dispute to arbitration.

27. PROPOSAL FORMAT

Proposal shall include enough information to satisfy evaluations that Contractor has the appropriate experience and qualifications to perform the scope of services as described. Contractor should ensure that their proposal contains sufficient information for the District to make its determination by presenting acceptable evidence to perform the services called for by the proposal.

a. Cover Letter - Introduction

A cover letter should be submitted on the Vendor's official letterhead explaining the intent of the Vendor and a confirmation of the Vendor's understanding of the scope of the work to be performed.

b. Executive Summary

Provide an executive summary of the Vendor's plan as well as area(s) of expertise and resource capabilities it believes highlights its firm as superior or unique in addressing the needs of the District as stated. If the Vendor cannot comply with any of the proposal terms, an explanation of those exceptions must be supplied.

c. Company Background and Experience - References

Vendor should provide a brief description of their company including a brief history, organizational structure, years in business, and other short details that would be of interest about the company. Detailed discussion shall include prior experience in working on projects of similar size, scope, and function to this proposal.

27. PROPOSAL FORMAT - continued

Vendor should describe experience with other clients locally or out of state with school entities of similar size and diversity, and with references from clients including names and telephone numbers. Specifically, three (3) references from existing clients that include client's name, client contact, e-mail address, and telephone number.

d. Approach and Methodology

Proposals should include any resources for project implementation or deployment. Present creative solutions or innovative concepts to meet the needs of the District for consideration. Proposal should include enough information to satisfy evaluators that the Vendor has the appropriate experience, knowledge, and qualifications to perform the services described. Include a project timeline to help visualize a successful proposal implementation.

e. Staff Qualifications and Training

Vendor should provide detailed information about the experience and qualifications of the Vendor's assigned personnel considered key to the success of the project. This information should include education, training, technical experience, functional experience, roles and responsibilities, and any applicable certifications.

f. Cost Proposal

The fees and costs proposed by the Vendor shall be submitted using the format found in the (Attachment).

g. Certification Statement

The Vendor must sign and submit the Certification Statement provided with this Proposal. The statement must be signed by an individual who is authorized to make proposals in the name of the firm making the Proposal.

h. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals that meet the preliminary screening requirements for review will be evaluated based on information provided in the Proposal. The evaluation of each response will be scored based on the overall competence, compliance, format, and organization, taking into account the evaluation criteria listed below.

- 1. References 10 points maximum score
- 2. Staff Qualifications and Training 25 points maximum score
- 3. Approach and Methodology (Proposed Plan) 25 points maximum score
- 4. Proposed Pricing Structure/Fees 40 points maximum score

Maximum score total is 100 points.
