YMCA FEES AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OPTIONS

FULL PAY PARTICIPANTS:

- Enrollment fee: \$30 per student non-refundable
- Monthly fee: \$200 per student YMCA members (approx. \$2.85 per day)
\$240 per student non YMCA members (approx \$3.42 per day)
- Monthly fee for additional child: \$180 per student YMCA members (\$2.57 per day)
\$216 per student non members (\$3.08 per day)
- Weekly fee: \$50 per student YMCA members
\$60 per student non members
- Weekly fee for additional child: \$45 per student YMCA members
\$54 per student non members
- Punch card for drop in care: 10 days for \$150 to be used any day that care is needed
- Late fee: \$1 per minute per child starting at 6:35pm



OPEN DOOR PARTICIPANTS:

- Enrollment fee: \$30 per student non-refundable
- Monthly fee: \$150 per student YMCA members (approx \$2.14 per day)
\$180 per student non YMCA members (approx \$2.57 per day)
- Monthly fee for additional child: \$180 per student YMCA members (\$2.57 per day)
\$216 per student non members (\$3.08 per day)
- Weekly fee: \$37.50 per student YMCA members
\$45 per student non members
- Punch card for drop in care: 10 days for \$112.50 to be used any day that care is needed
- Late fee: \$1 per minute per child starting at 6:35pm
- Open door qualifiers: Free and reduced lunch, SNAP, Medicaid, CHIP, HUD/Section 8 or WIC.
- GISD Employee Rate:** \$38.50 per student



Need-Based Assistance

If you don't have any of the Open Doors qualifiers but still need assistance, Need Based Assistance is also available. The Y offers up to 50% off programs based on income or need. Participants will be required to provide documentation for income as well as tax information. Scholarships at this level will be provided based on income and number of family members in the household.
