Substance Abuse Treatment Options for Adolescents:

1. **MHSD on Elysian Fields** 6 month program which includes weekly group therapy sessions on M or W and drug testing a few times. Contact Al Franklin at 504-620-2460.
2. **MHSD in Arabi:** Ethan Nicholas, LAC sees adolescents for weekly individual therapy. Will give random drug screens 2-3 times per month. To make a referral, contact Renata Starks-Brown 504-620-2603
3. **FINS Substance Use Program**—weekly therapy groups, random drug screens 2-3x per week
4. **CADA**—28 day residential program for adolescents located in Shreveport. Medicaid will transport
