

Bus Rules

BE SAFE

1. Walk to the bus stop with a friend or trusted adult when possible.
2. Wait quietly for the bus a safe distance away from the road.
3. Keep out of the Danger Zone, which is 10 feet all around the bus.
4. Board and exit bus after it comes to a complete stop.
5. Stay seated with your feet on the floor, facing forward.
6. Keep head, hands and feet inside the bus.
7. Keep your hands, feet and objects to yourself and out of the aisle.
8. If you must cross the street to get to or off a bus, cross in front and wait for the bus driver to signal to you that it is safe to cross.
9. Never pick up something that is near or under the bus. First, let the driver know so that an item can be safely retrieved.



BE RESPECTFUL

1. Talk quietly; do not yell or make loud noises.
2. Obey the bus driver.
3. Use appropriate language; no profanity.
4. Do not push, shove or fight.

BE RESPONSIBLE

1. Get up early enough so you don't have to rush to the bus stop or miss the bus.
2. Keep the bus clean.
3. Do not tamper with or damage bus equipment.
4. Do not eat or drink.
5. Do not throw objects.



BE POSITIVE

1. Be polite and considerate.
2. Report any problems to the bus driver.
3. Smile at the bus driver and others.
