# SPECIAL EDUCATION

## ❖ **Special Education Coordinator - Mr. Roy Cucullu**

### ❖ **Inclusion**

- Inclusion teachers push into regular education classrooms to assist students with IEPs and meet their academic needs and accommodations
- 4 special education inclusion teachers at the Ninth Grade Academy
- 8 inclusion teachers on the main campus

### ❖ **LEAP Connect**

- LEAP Connect teachers are self-contained teachers for the core subjects of LEAP Connect students
- 4 LEAP Connect teachers at CHS on the main campus
- LEAP Connect students take the LEAP Connect exams instead of the subject-based LEAP2025 exams



# 504

## ❖ **504 Coordinator - Mrs. Joy Taylor**

- ❖ Students receive their 504 accommodations for each course by the classroom teacher
- ❖ Students can receive these accommodations on classroom assessments as well as LEAP2025, preACT, and WorkKeys.
- ❖ Accommodation requests are applied for prior to taking the ACT
- ❖ Once a year the student and parent will meet with Mrs. Taylor and a teacher to discuss update the students' 504 plan.



# ENGLISH LANGUAGE LEARNERS

- ❖ **ELL Coordinator - Ms. Marnie Chiasson**
- ❖ ELL students take the ELPT test to determine levels of English proficiency in listening, reading, writing, and speaking.
- ❖ Based on the ELPT scores, a Limited English Proficiency Accommodation Plan may be written to determine what accommodations must be put in place for the student to succeed.
- ❖ Students can receive these accommodations on classroom assessments as well as LEAP2025 and ACT.
- ❖ Once a year the LEP plan will be updated.
