The Governor of the State of Iowa, the Iowa High School Athletic Association and the Iowa Girls High School Athletic Union have granted approval for baseball and softball to hold abbreviated seasons. We are excited, but understand that it is necessary to proceed with caution and pay very close attention to details.

Both the baseball and softball teams have published information for tryouts. These materials provide all the information necessary to properly prepare for those workouts on Monday, June 1st, 2020.

Each program will be following guidelines issued by the Iowa Department of Public Health, Scott County Health Department as well as the Iowa High School Athletic Association and the Iowa High School Girls Union. As a result, practices and games will look differently than they have in the past. More guidance will be made available about the changes as we get closer to competitions.

The Davenport Community School District wants to be clear that participation in these seasons is a choice. Anyone, player or coach, is free to decide not to participate. These decisions will be respected and not held against either a player or a coach in years to come. Coaches can return to coach next season and players with eligibility remaining will be welcomed back to try out in the summer of 2021.
