Community Service Guidelines for Davenport Central High School Students

- Community service is an unpaid activity that aims to benefit individuals, groups, or community agencies.
- Community service is an activity that is not part of an academic, court-ordered, or discipline requirement.
- Community service cannot take place when an academic class is scheduled.
- Church activities that benefit the community would be considered acceptable. Attending church
 or Sunday school would not count as acceptable hours; teaching Sunday school would count as
 hours.
- Membership in an organization alone does not count toward community service hours; taking part in a service project that organization is supporting would count.
- Babysitting for family members does not count toward community service hours.
- If you have questions about a specific activity not listed here, please see Ms. Thovson or Ms. Cox.
- You must log a total of 40 hours during your high school experience to earn graduation recognition
- A separate log sheet and Agreement must be used for each community service activity/location
- Sheets should be turned in upon completion; do NOT wait to turn them all in at once
- THE DEADLINE FOR ALL COMMUNITY SERVICE PAPERWORK IS MAY 1; NO FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS DATE

To Get Started:

- 1. Pick up the Community Service Agreement Sheet AND a Student Log Sheet from the guidance office.
- 2. Have the supervisor fill out the Community Service Agreement Sheet and begin your hours.
- 3. Log hours AND turn in both sheets to either Ms. Thovson or Ms. Cox
