## **CHANGE:**

**Reference: Page 7, Section B, General Information.** The daily number of substitute teachers and substitute paraprofessionals provided was calculated in error. The updated information is shown in red below.

## **B. GENERAL INFORMATION**

The District serves approximately 4,300 students (the student population changes annually) with approximately 690 full time staff (including approximately 295 teachers) at 5 elementary schools, 2 middle schools, 2 high schools, and additional administrative facilities. Asheville City Schools currently utilizes an average of 30 substitute teachers and 10 substitute paraprofessionals on a daily basis.

The following questions were received from one or more Bidders. The answers to the questions is shown in red below.

## **QUESTIONS:**

- 1. It gives us the option to either submit our proposal digitally or by mail. Do you have a preference?

  Digital is preferred, but either is perfectly acceptable.
- 2. It is asking for 5 NC District references. We currently have contracts with 7 NC districts however 4 of those do not start until next month when school starts back. Are you only looking for districts that have been using our services for a certain amount of time? I know that no other company has that many districts in the state so it may be hard to supply that many active references.
