Isaac Dickson Student Cellular Device Policy

At Isaac Dickson we understand that cell phones have become an important tool with which parents communicate with their children before and after school. Because all classrooms are equipped with phones, students are not allowed to use cellular phones, or other wireless communication devices, during the school day. In accordance with board policy, students with signed permission from parents/guardians, may have cellular devices (including phones and watches) to use before and after school. These devices are to be turned OFF and stored in the students' backpacks or other school approved location during the school day.

Consequences for unauthorized use

School employees may immediately confiscate any wireless communication device that is on, used, displayed, or visible in violation of this policy.

1st offense device confiscated and returned to student at the end of the day 2nd offense device confiscated and returned to a parent by administration 3rd offense cell phone privileges revoked for the remainder of the school year

4th offense In-school Suspension

Liability

Students are personally and solely responsible for the safety and security of their wireless communication devices. The school system is not responsible for the theft, loss, or damage of a cellular phone or any other personal wireless communication device.
