


EC 2.4 The average RIT Score of Grade 2 students' NWEA MAP Growth performance will increase from 171 to 185 by the end of the year.		




Kindergarten BOY mClass Reading Composite


Kindergarten MOY mClass Reading Composite






Kindergarten EOY mClass Reading Composite








Kindergarten Dyslexia Screener

Under HB3, we are required to conduct the Dyslexia Screener to determine who may be "At Risk" of dyslexia, and will need further observation in 1st grade.

In the past, students who had been flagged "At Risk" in kindergarten were placed in Rtl Reading Labs in 1st grade, in an attempt to close gaps and increase proficiency.


This year, ZERO students have been identified as "At Risk". However, we have identified 5 students with significant gaps who will receive Rtl Reading Lab intervention.
