



Immunization Requirements

2024-2025

Please upload your child's **current** immunization record to the **Immunization Record** section of your Requirement Library in your Magnus Health account.

For attendance in pre-kindergarten:

Please contact your pediatrician or health center for a copy of your son's immunization record in accordance with PA DOH guidelines.

For attendance in all grades K-12:

- 4 doses of DTP or DTaP or DT or Td (1 dose on or after 4th birthday)
- 4 doses of polio*
- 2 doses MMR
- 3 doses of hepatitis B
- 2 doses of varicella vaccine (or history of disease)

*Or 3 doses if 3rd dose at 4 years old or older and at least 6 months after previous dose

For boys entering 7th grade:

- 1 dose of Tdap (if 5 years have elapsed since last tetanus immunization)
- 1 dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine (MCV)

For boys entering 12th grade:

- 2nd MCV (if first given prior to age 16)

Provisional Admittance

Any student may be admitted provisionally if at least one dose of each required antigen for vaccines given in a series is given. The parents' plan for completion of the required immunizations shall be submitted to the school and reviewed every 30 DAYS. All subsequent immunizations shall be recorded into the system. **All immunization requirements should be completed within 5 DAYS of entrance to school.** If the requirements are not met, the school administrator shall undertake exclusion measures.

Exemptions for immunizations are: MEDICAL REASONS • RELIGIOUS BELIEFS • PHILOSOPHICAL/STRONG MORAL OR ETHICAL CONVICTION. Please contact THS Health Office for exemption waiver information. If your child is exempt from immunizations, he may be removed from school during an outbreak
